

Consent to the Processing of Personal Data

This consent to the processing of personal data is given for the purpose of inclusion in the List of Evaluators, maintaining records of evaluators, and contacting evaluators regarding evaluation activities based on their assessed expertise.

The consent covers the processing of personal data in the following scope:

- a) title, first name and surname,
- b) contact details: email address,
- c) area of expertise and professional specialization.

Providing consent is voluntary. You may withdraw your consent at any time without giving a reason:

- a) by post to the Slovak Academy of Sciences, or
- b) by email to: gdpr@urad.sav.sk or cooperation@urad.sav.sk.

To help us process your request efficiently, please indicate that it concerns personal data processed in connection with your inclusion in the List of Evaluators.

Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

By giving your consent to be included in the List of Evaluators, you confirm that you have been informed about the processing of your personal data.

Information on the Processing of Personal Data pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (General Data Protection Regulation – GDPR)

2. Data Protection Officer

The Data Protection Officer oversees compliance with personal data protection requirements and provides information regarding the processing of personal data.

3. Purpose of Processing

We process your personal data for the following purposes:

- creation and maintenance of the List of Evaluators,
- selection of suitable evaluators for specific assignments, including participation in evaluation panels or committees,
- communication with evaluators,
- administration and record-keeping related to evaluation activities.

4. Legal Basis for Processing

The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is your consent pursuant to Article 6(1)(a) GDPR.

If you are selected to perform a specific evaluation activity, your personal data may subsequently also be processed on the basis of:

- performance of a contract pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) GDPR,
- compliance with a legal obligation pursuant to Article 6(1)(c) GDPR.

5. Categories of Personal Data Processed

For the purposes described above, we may process:

- title, first name and surname,
- email address,
- area of expertise and professional specialization.

6. Recipients of Personal Data

Your personal data may be disclosed to:

- authorised employees of the Controller,
- public authorities where required by applicable law.

7. Transfers to Third Countries or International Organisations

Your personal data will not be transferred to countries outside the European Economic Area or to international organisations.

8. Retention Period

Your personal data will be retained for the duration of your consent and your inclusion in the List of Evaluators, but no longer than 10 years from the date consent is given.

9. Rights of the Data Subject

The data subject has the right to:

- **request access to their personal data** (Article 15 GDPR) – you have the right to obtain information as to whether we process your personal data and to receive a copy of the personal data we hold about you;

- **request rectification of inaccurate or incomplete personal data** (Article 16 GDPR) – if your personal data is inaccurate or incomplete, you may request that it be corrected or supplemented;
- **request erasure of personal data** (Article 17 GDPR) – under the conditions set out in the GDPR, you may request the erasure of your personal data;
- **request restriction of processing** (Article 18 GDPR) – in certain circumstances, you may request that we temporarily limit the processing of your personal data;
- **object to processing** in cases provided for by the GDPR (Article 21 GDPR) – where permitted by applicable law, you may object to the processing of your personal data;
- **exercise the right to data portability** (Article 20 GDPR) – you have the right to receive your personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format or to request that it be transmitted to another controller;
- **withdraw your consent at any time** (Article 7(3) GDPR) – you may withdraw your consent in the same manner in which it was given. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal;
- **lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority** (Article 77 GDPR) – if you believe that the processing of your personal data infringes the GDPR, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Office for Personal Data Protection of the Slovak Republic.

11. Automated Decision-Making

Your personal data is not subject to automated individual decision-making, including profiling, within the meaning of Article 22 GDPR.
